Kesho Kenya works to create a Coast of Kenya where all the young people are educated, fulfil their potential and broaden their experience to the world, irrespective of their poverty, ethnicity and religion and gender or special needs.

MISSION

To advance access to education and employment for vulnerable young people living in the coast of Kenya, through a long-term holistic approach.

FACTS

- 3,200 children educated from primary school to university
- 99% of Kesho Kenya Primary School beneficiaries have transited to secondary school (2/3 to National schools)
- 95% of Kesho Kenya's secondary school leavers transition to university or college
- We work with 128 primary and secondary schools in Kilifi County
- We support 12,920 girls in Kilifi County through Wasichana Wetu Wafaulu (Let Our Girls Succeed!) project
- more than 1,600 children reached in 2018 with our safeguarding program

- Winner of the Rising Star Foundation Award in 2013

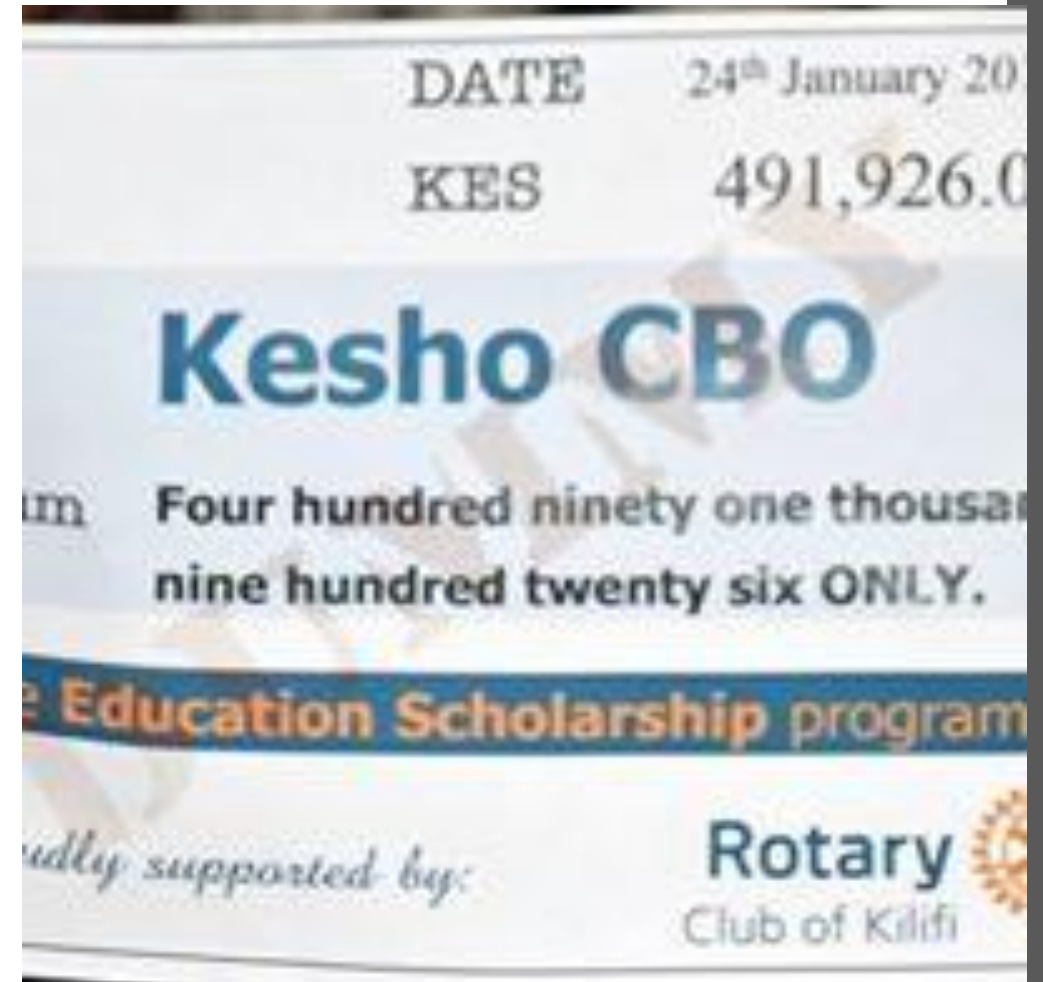
